CRLP202

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CRLP202 is a subject for UOW undergraduate students undertaking an approved internship with an industry partner.

Students complete a 100-hour internship at the beginning of one of the designated Autumn-Extended or Winter/Spring internship periods. Specific dates are outlined in the timeline (pg. 6).

During the semester, students complete the academic component of the subject: four collaborative workshops and a series of individual assessments. Through these activities, students will reflect on their whole-of-internship journey to explore questions and articulate their strengths, skills, and values. This subject aims to support students in approaching important career decisions with clarity and confidence.

THE STUDENTS

CRLP202 is an elective subject, available to **any** eligible UOW undergraduate student. Students from all disciplines are encouraged to undertake this subject to create a diverse, transdisciplinary learning environment. Students will primarily be in their **second year of study**.

THE IDEAL INTERNSHIP

- Internships are welcomed from **all disciplines in UOW's faculties.**
- 100 hours to be completed between **30 Jun –10 Oct 2025.**
- Can be part-time or fulltime: working pattern to be negotiated between an industry partner and the student.
- Will be a learning opportunity for students to contribute to real business operations; however, an intern's responsibilities should not replace the work of essential operational staff.



BENEFITS OF HOSTING A STUDENT INTERN

- **Welcome fresh perspectives** that can promote creativity and **encourage innovation within your team.**
- An opportunity to **give back to students and contribute to developing local talent** in your industry.
- **Professional development opportunities for current staff** to gain experience in mentoring, supervision, and leadership.
- Develop relationships with future hires and establish your **talent pipeline.**

FAQs

Are the internship dates flexible?

Ideally, internships will be undertaken within the specified window to meet the requirements of CRLP202 Career Ready Learning & Experience. Internship end dates can be extended on a case-by-case basis, to accommodate unplanned events, such as student illness or staff holidays.

Are CRLP202 internships paid or unpaid?

An internship can be lawfully unpaid if it is a course requirement and is approved by the university. However, we encourage industry partners to offer paid internships where possible.

Who provides insurance coverage for students undertaking an internship?

For unpaid internships, UOW insurance for students is available (subject to approval). For paid internships, insurance coverage for students is to be provided by the industry partner.

Please note that UOW requires all industry partners to have in place appropriate insurances in order to host student interns including public liability (minimum \$10m) and professional indemnity cover.
